BYLD (Building Youth as Leaders who are Disciples of Christ) July 7-12, 2025, is a week-long event for high school students that focuses on leadership skills, theological education, and discernment all from the perspective of the NALC's four Core Values: Christ Centered, Mission Driven, Traditionally Grounded, and Congregationally Focused.
